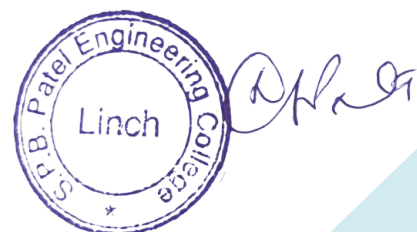
NATIONAL ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION COUNCIL

Objectives of the Alumni




- To bring all alumni spread across the globe into a single network and connect among them and with the Institute to strengthen the bond between its members and the Institute and work towards a shared common interest

- To organize and establish scholarship funds to help the needy and deserving students.

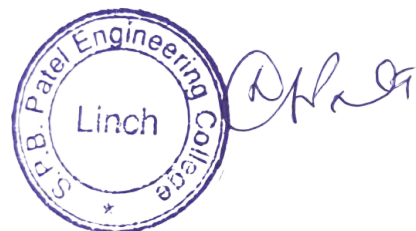

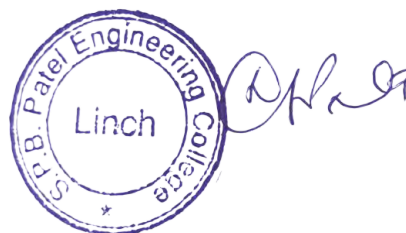

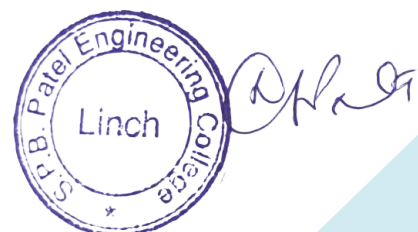
2. Mentorship and Networking: Our Alumni offer mentorship to our current students by sharing their experiences, offering career advice, and providing networking opportunities.

And don't forget to **note down** all the points that will surely help to keep you safe and secure in this world of online fraud and cyber crimes!





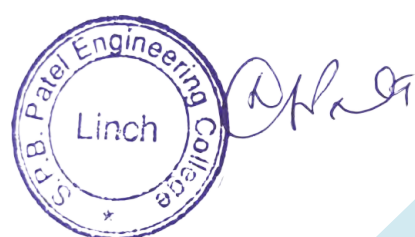


2.SHYAM HATHALIA SESSION

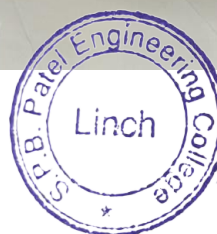

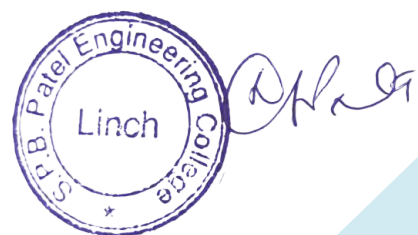

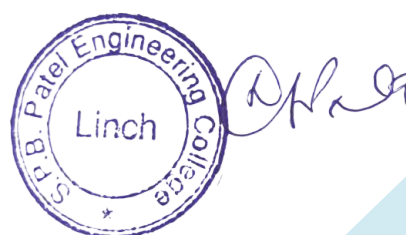
